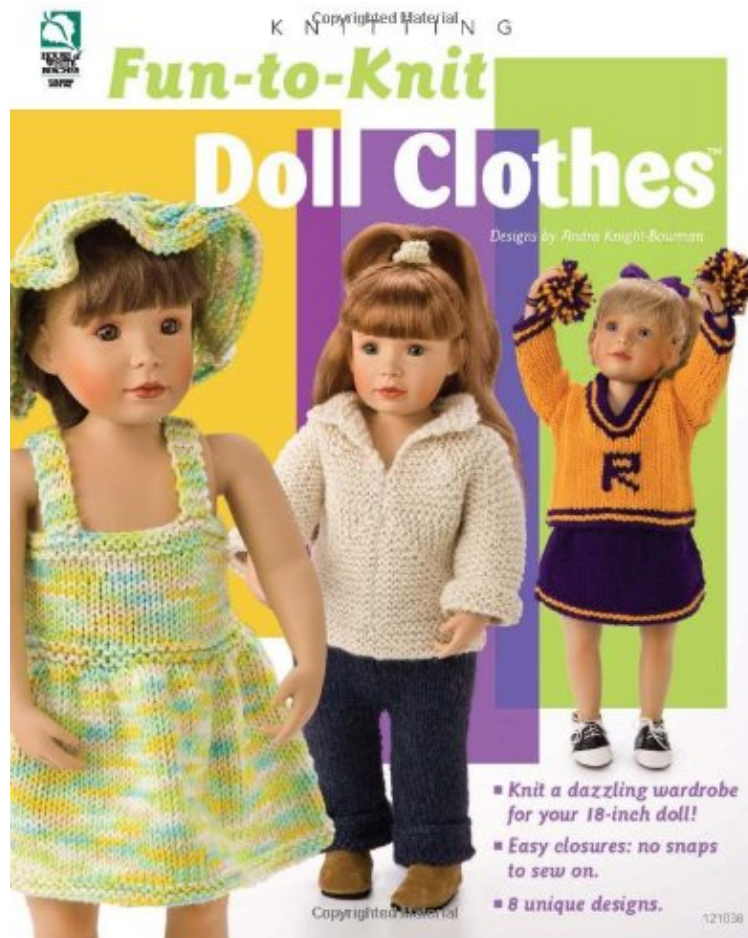

With complete instructions for knitting an entire wardrobe for an 18-inch doll, this guidebook for creating miniature garments will delight knitters young and old. Quick and fun, these patterns simplify the previously tedious and time consuming aspects of making doll clothes, such as stitching on closure snaps or hook-and-eye closures. The garment patterns include a skirt, long pants, shorts, hats, sweaters, and more. Copiously illustrated and featuring detailed color photographs, this reference is an ideal resource for creating clothes for a beloved doll.

Oct 10 Andra was seven years old when she learned to knit, and we reckon she drew on her memories of playtime when designing the fantastic projects in this book. The clothes will fit a 46cm or 18in tall doll and there are 14 garments to knit, including a sundress, skirt, cheerleader's outfit, bathrobe and slippers. The emphasis here is very much on 'easy', so most knitters will find these knits a cinch. There's no stitching on snaps or hook-and-eye closures involved - all of the clothes are slip on, which means simpler knitting for you. This is an American book, so UK readers will want to convert the measurements into centimetres (though we know lots of you prefer inches).
