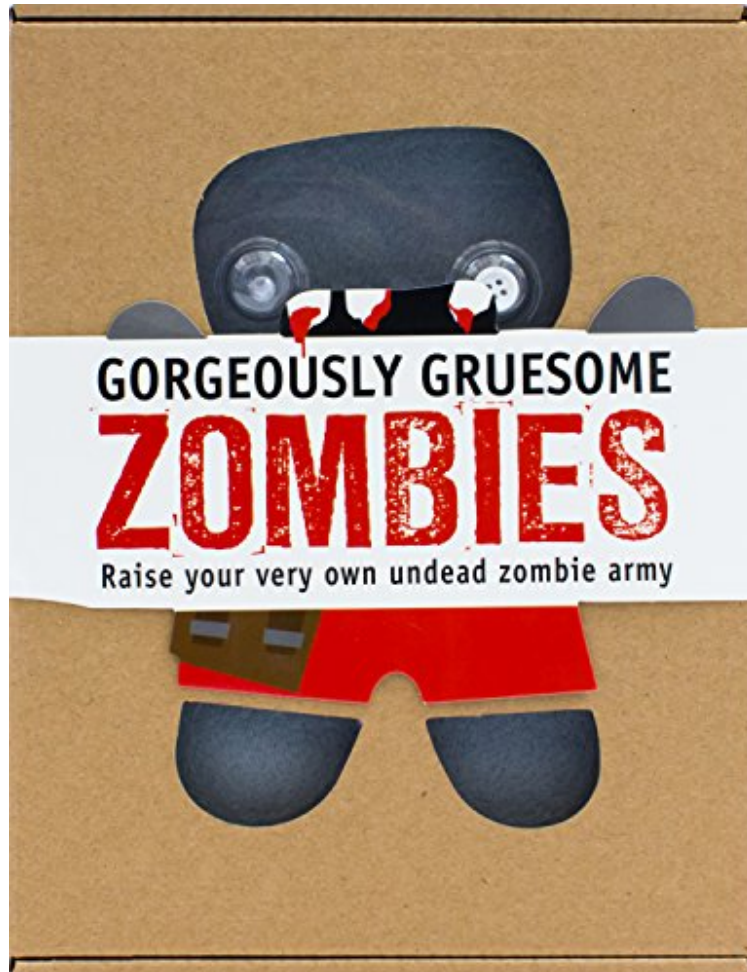

This kit only makes one zombie (hardly an army) and gives instructions on how to make more with your own materials. Tons of funBy SarahAs others have said, you will need your own crafting supplies to complete this kit. The marketing of this box as a "complete" kit was a bit deceptive, and basically you are simply purchasing a book of instructions. However if you can look past the marketing, the crafting experience was tons of fun. I actually had a blast going through my own crafting supplies and finding the odd

bits (embroidery thread, beads, buttons, felt bits, fabric bits, glue, fiberfill) then going to the craft store with purpose to seek out the bits I didn't already have from my home supply. For me it was a lot of fun being able to use the copious amounts of crafting supplies I've established over the years, and having a real reason to go to the craft store. The shorter form craft instruction book (with instructions for 8 zombies using relatively basic supplies) wasn't as overwhelming for me as most craft books where I end up stalling at the decision stage of which item to make and which supplies to use. The pattern pages are a little cramped and will need to be photocopied or traced but depending on your crafting style, this was part of the fun of the process. The resulting zombie plushies are the perfect size to make a mobile. I have made all the zombies in this book and ended up purchasing all the other related "kits" (aka books in a box) which include "dastardly delightful monsters", "Enticingly Eccentric Gnomes", and "wonderfully wicked witches". 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. Ya it's short on supplies, but still a lot of fun! By Jessica Litke I got this at a white elephant gift exchange and I really had a fun time with it! Yes it only includes enough felt for the "zombie kid" and doesn't come with a needle, glue, scissors, or fiber-fill, but I made it work with what I had around the house (needle, Elmer's/super glue, scissors, and cotton balls). I brought my little zombie kid to work and everyone got a kick out of him! The book also includes instructions for 7 other adorable zombies, of which I have made several for random gifts. It is a detail oriented craft but if you have basic craft supplies at home you really will only need to get felt if you make more than 1 zombie. I've thoroughly enjoyed it.
