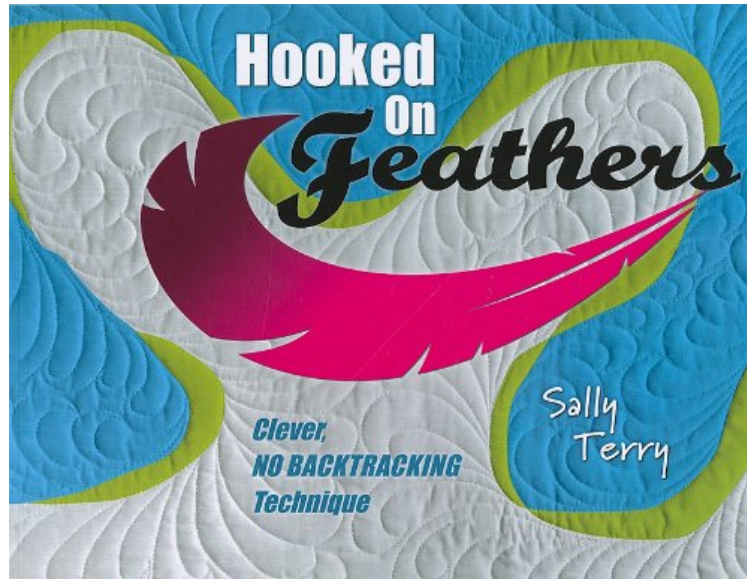

The motion used is a bit different and takes a little practice. But the results are much nicer than anything I've done before in the feather line.
