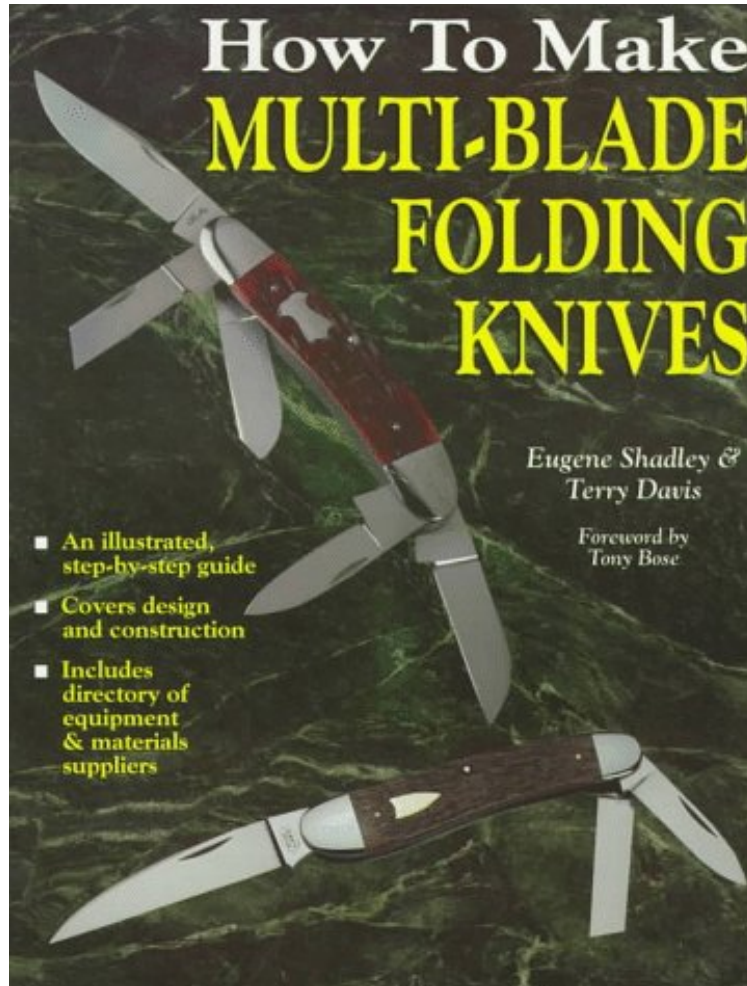

The methods vary a bit, but were similar. Most importantly the methods were very detailed, with sufficient images to support the text. Overall anyone that has made knives for a while will view most of the material as common sense, however there is enough good infomation to keep a seasoned maker engaged. Some of the materials and suppliers listed in the back are outdated, but it is easy to locate replacements on the internet.As a side note, I read a review that complained about wide array of tools employed by the authors to make their knives. This individual apparently wanted to make a knife without serous tools. His poor review is what sold me on the book.Unfortunatley this book appears out of print, so copies may not be easy to come by. While this book is presented as a "how to" publication. It is in fact only a couple of knifemakers' accounts of how to make two of their favorite knives. Any aspiring multi-blade folder maker must understand right up front that following our "recipes" will not assure comparable results - mine doesn't even work the same way for me every time. Neither do those who have found some measure of success with these folders all use the same techniques. It has become apparent that there are nearly as many ways to make a folder as there are foldermakers. Our goal in writing this book is to help the knifemaker struggling to make multi-blades find some useful information herein that will help him find his own way through the process.
