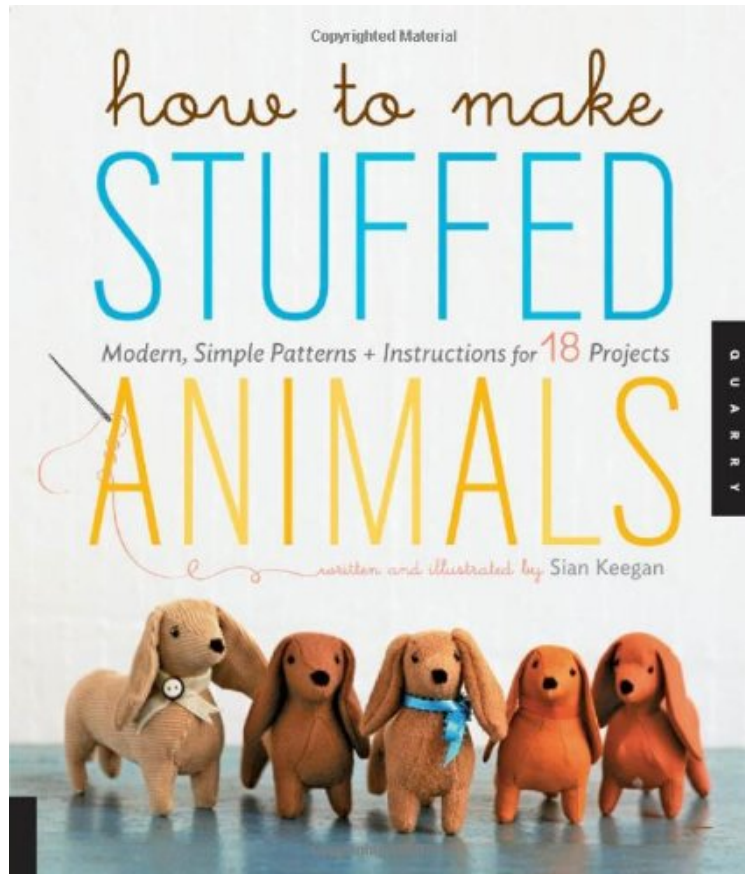

This double enlargement gave me a squirrel that was lifesize and a pattern that was large enough to work on a sewing machine.
