It teaches attitude toward the materials, as well as methods of preserving them, techniques in arranging them, choices of containers, and equipment needed to produce the timeless simplicity of Japanese flower arrangements. In Japanese homes there's a special niche called a tokonoma, in which the flower arrangements express the beauty of the changing seasons.
