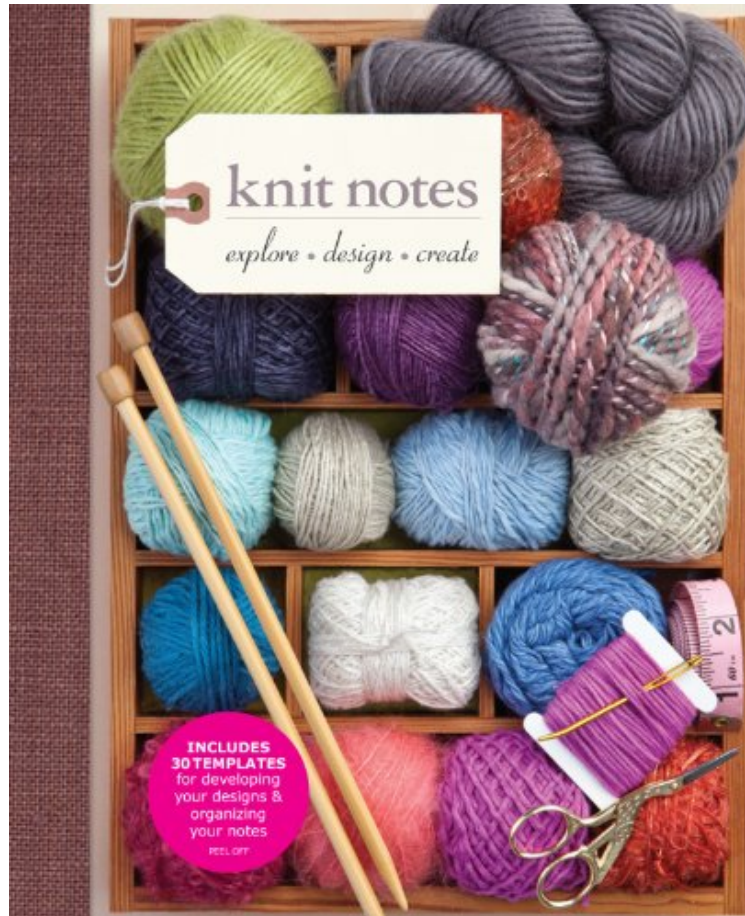

Because I hadn't kept count of my rows--nor written down the issue of the knitting magazine containing the pattern!-- when I picked up the project two years after I'd begun. Lesson learned, I started writing down which row I'd finished on the margins of patterns, which essentially got scribbled over the next time I attempted the pattern in another size. Then voila! I discovered this book. Not only does it keeps track of needles used, yarns and lot numbers, but it allows you to sketch out your own pattern (perfect for initials!) and make notes about pattern adjustments. Plus you can keep your notes all in one neat, contained space. Whether experienced or just getting started, this book would make an awesome holiday gift--maybe packaged with some beautiful yarn? Most knitters dream of making their own creative knitwear designs. This notebook turns dreams into reality. Each of the approximately 30 blank journal entries includes space for inspirational materials, information on yarn, tools, and gauge, project instructions, and a photo of the finished project. Also included are two types of graph paper--one for sketching a silhouette/schematic, the other for creating stitch charts--a sample garment pattern, outlines of basic shapes, and information on measurements and yarn. There's even a ruler printed on the inside back cover!
