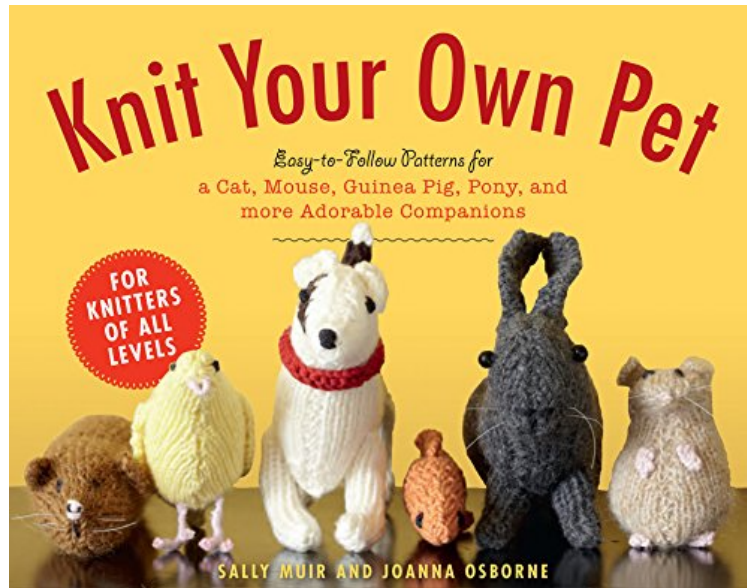

live forever!
