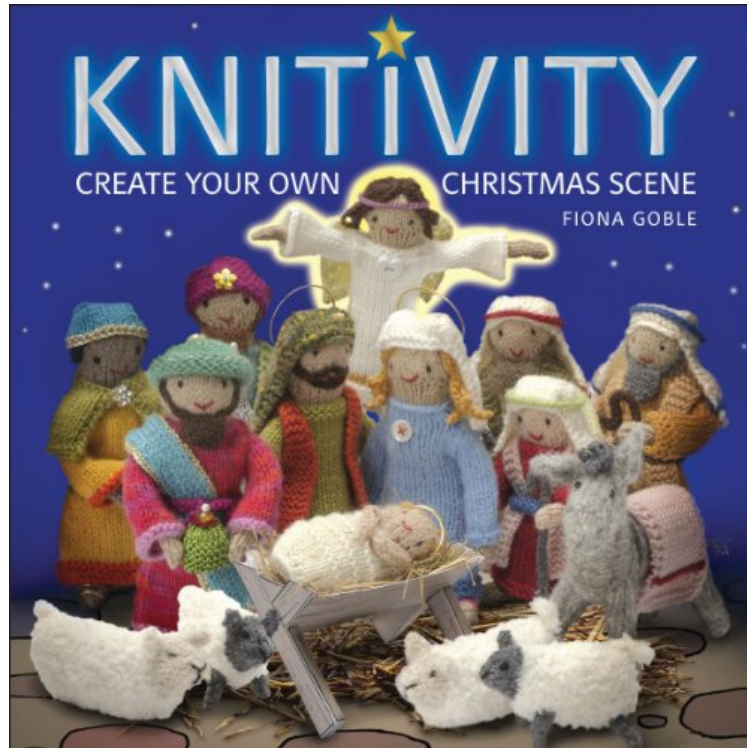

I have just finished the complete set. I ended up purchasing yarn for the project as I didn't have any suitable scraps. I used Jamieson Shetland wool DK which comes in a host of vibrant colors. I plan to use the left-overs on some of Ms Goble's other delightful books. The figures are quite straightforward to knit and the sewing up and finishing took maybe an hour or two per figure.I would like to note that there is a error in the pattern for the Ox. I have not been able to find an errata online. On page 39 the 2nd line that says "Work 9 rows in st st, beg with a K row" needs to be eliminated. The instructions should readNext row: Bind off 5 sts, K to end [34 sts]Next row: Bind off 5 sts pwise, K to end [29 sts]Otherwise your Ox will look weird.I also found that I needed more than 48 yards to knit the Ox, more like 60-70 yds.8 of 8 people found the following review helpful.
