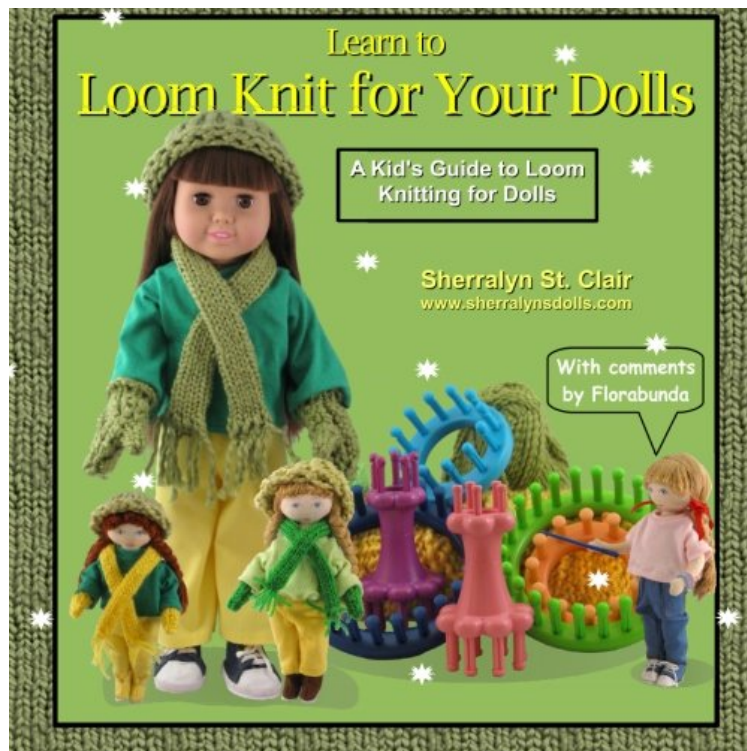

The format is easy to follow, clean and colorful. It has very good instructions, diagrams and pictures for using looms.
