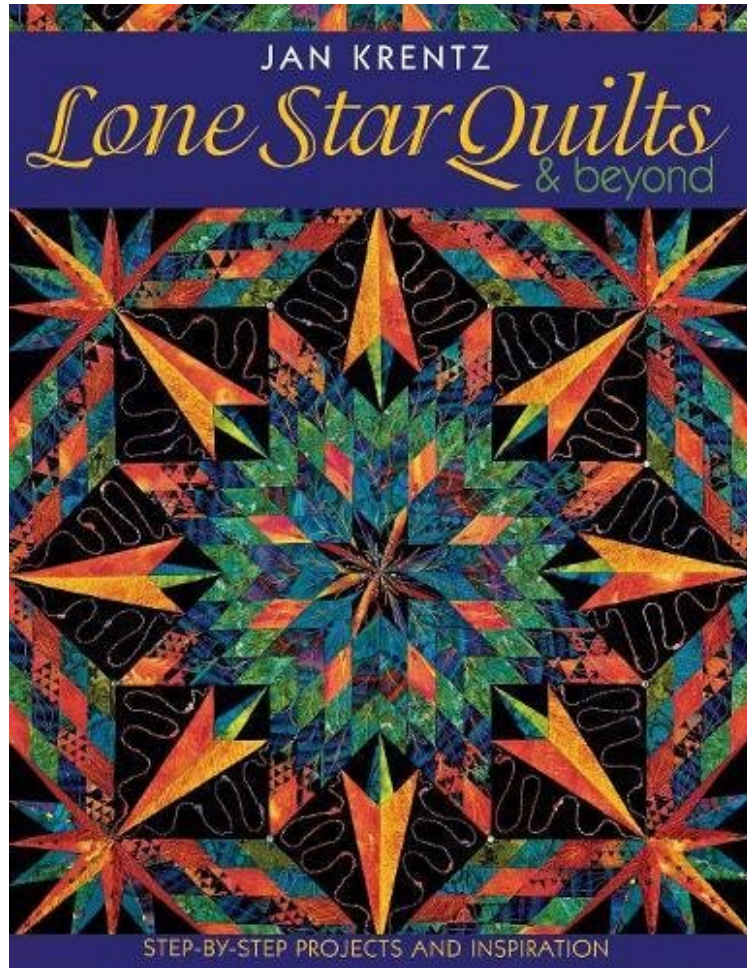

The teachings in her class follow the book in the same sort of well-laid-out, thoughtful, clear language that makes this sometimes hard-as-heck quilt to make almost easy-peasy-eggs-and-cheesy!The layouts are creative, the instructions clear, and the finished quilts stunning. Of course, I did a silly and changed sewing machines mid-stream (duh...) and had to take my corners off . . . (not to quilters - do NOT change your machine without measuring to see if the 1/4" foot from one to the other is the SAME quarter inch! Some are off a thread or two, and it really adds up.)If

While a lone star quilt is not a novice-level project, if one follows Jan's very clear instructions (and pays attention to her tips and tricks), you may take yourself from novice to near-expert in no time. The one thing lacking is gaining a mastery of precision piecing, which is essential to many of the projects in the book. For that, I'd recommend Sally Collins' Mastering Precision Piecing - Print on Demand Edition as a how-to in precise sewing of the blocks and sub-units in Jan's book.
