We have been able to do the basics of bracelets and necklaces etc. but thought we would try these creatures. I am very disappointed in this book and would like to try to return it if I can. It is completely impossible to follow. Even the "easy" pictures and directions are inadequate. It turned what was supposed to be a pleasant rainy afternoon activity into a frustrating experience for all.
