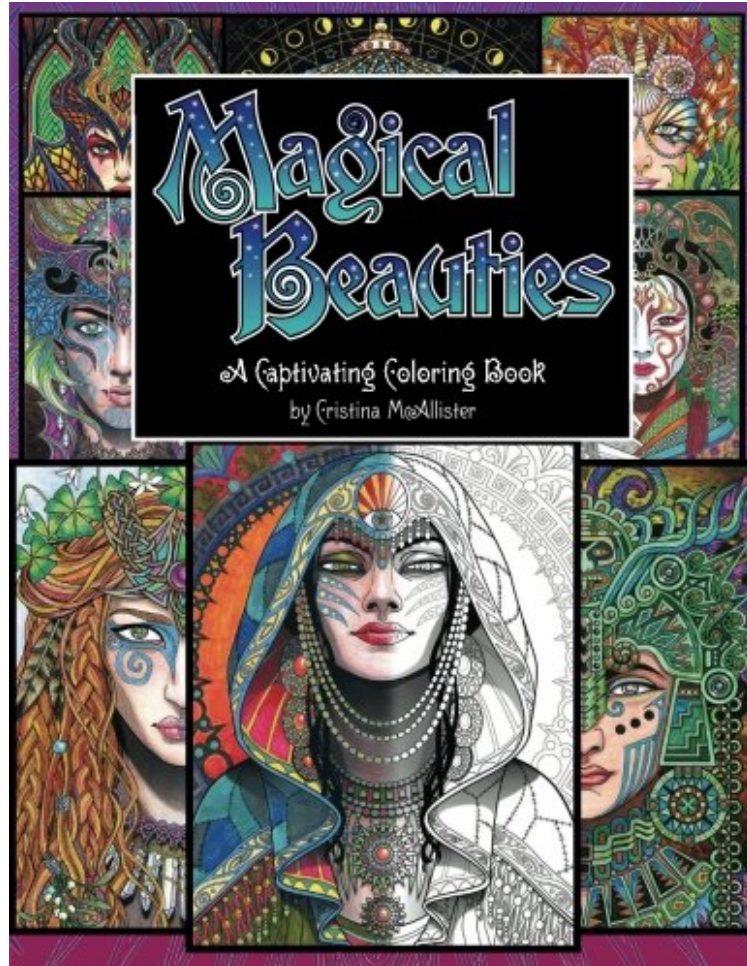

The pictures are gorgeous, especially if you like beautiful young women with the air of pagan goddesses. Most show just the head and neck, though some also have a little of the upper chest; it depends on the costume.I also like the level of detail, which is right for markers and for my attention span (Id guess one could finish a picture in about an hour). The pictures in some coloring books are so complex that it would take forever to finish one (like those puzzles with a thousand pieces) and also would be difficult to color within the lines except, perhaps, with colored pencils; conversely, those with lots of big areas show too much of the variation in color that is inevitable with most media. These are in between.My only complaint is that the paper in the book is a bit thin. You should either put a

piece of cardboard under the picture you're working on or remove it from the book to avoid bleed-through if you use markers or watercolor. Once you've removed and colored it, the picture does not lie completely flat either. If you like this kind of art, a sort of modern Art Nouveau, I can also recommend this author's Spirit Women; that has an even more pagan feel, though I personally like the pictures in Magical Beauties a bit better. There is also a lovely Dover coloring book by a different author (Miryam Adatto) but with a somewhat similar style, called Fanciful Faces. 5 of 5 people found the following review helpful.
